A CHALLENGE TO MOVE FORWARD...

WHY DO WE NEED A NEW CONFERENCE HALL?

To help meet the future practical needs of our students and guests:

- replacing a failing facility: all utility services such as plumbing and electrics have to be renewed and the heating system replaced
- updating the building to meet the expectations of today by replacing inadequate bedroom and bathroom facilities
- improving teaching and presentation facilities to meet the needs of this generation

To help meet the future spiritual needs of our students and guests:

- as we equip Christians to be more effective in their day to day lives
- as we develop and train future key leaders
- as we present the claims of Christ in a relevant style to all who come through our doors

In looking forward we seek to provide the teaching environment and resources that will enable us to reach, train and develop those in current and future generations as we play our part in the Church of Jesus Christ. We want to continue to be proactive in our development of a facility that the Lord has graciously used over many years to share and impart His life. We are grateful to Him that for our Bible School students and holiday guests Capernwray continues to be a place where "God changes lives" while also being a means of impact upon our local community.

WHAT WILL IT OFFER?

Conference Hall: An enlarged and more efficient use of space, better access, with improved sound, lighting and AV facilities

A foyer and first floor room will provide greater flexibility for programmes and display. The external appearance will be more in keeping with the Hall and fit more sympathetically into the environment of Capernwray

Bedrooms: Twelve 3-5 bedded rooms with ensuite facilities, suitable for conference and student accommodation

Offices: Increased area dedicated to administration and office space

WHAT WILL IT COST?

The initial Quantity Surveyor's estimate was £2 million, although with some alterations to the plans this should be reduced. In addition there will be consultants' fees in the region of £150,000. Our aim will be to keep the total costs within a budget of £2 million.

WHEN WILL IT HAPPEN?

Our desire is for the work to start in September 2009 with completion in June 2010. To this end we currently have our architect and various consultants working on the details of the project so we can be in a position to send out tenders in during July 2009. However in order to be able to meet this schedule, we need to know that we have a large proportion of the funding in place before the directors will approve signing a contract.
